



ACCOMMODATION

International students must live in one of the following categories of accommodation to enrol at Broadgreen Intermediate:

- ❖ Live with their parents
- ❖ Live with a designated caregiver

❖ **Designated Caregivers**

If an international student's parents select accommodation for the student, the signatory must:

- Have an indemnity documents signed by the international student's parents stating that the parents take full responsibility for the placement of the student with the designated caregiver(s), (which is attached) or parents interviewed by Principal and placement options confirmed.
 - Prior to enrolling the student, visit the home to (a) determine that the living conditions are of an acceptable standard, and (b) meet the designated caregiver and establish communication with the caregiver.
 - Meet with the student at least once a term to ensure that the accommodation is suitable.
- ❖ The signatory may require that a police vet be undertaken if it considers appropriate or if this is in line with the signatory's policy.

STATEMENT OF DESIGNATED CAREGIVER ARRANGEMENTS

I/We acknowledge that I/We have decided to place my/our child within the care of a caregiver vetted and monitored by myself/ourselves in order for them to attend Broadgreen Intermediate School as an International / Foreign Fee Paying Student. Accordingly I/We take full responsibility and accept the decisions made by my/our designated caregiver about the homestay placement and day to day requirements of my/our child.

I/We do however understand that Broadgreen Intermediate School will make every endeavour to provide for the care and welfare of my/our child at all times while studying in their school.
