What does it mean to be a S.T.A.R at Broadgreen?













These are our STAR rules, they provide the 'anchor' to which our behaviours are attached.

They form the basis of "The Broadgreen Way".



WHEN STUDENTS DISPLAY POSITIVE BEHAVIOURS -

They may:

- * get class rewards
- * earn incentive points and STAR certificates
- * be given STAR spot prizes
- * be nominated for end of year awards
- * get positive school reports that you will love and may reward!

They will:

- * FEEL PROUD OF THEMSELVES
- * HAVE ACCESS TO ALL SCHOOL PROGRAMMES
- * BE RESPECTED



THERE WILL BE CONSEQUENCES FOR THOSE WHO DO NOT DISPLAY POSITIVE BEHAVIOURS.

They may:

- * be redirected or retaught
- * be referred to other adults
- * be given a behaviour contract
- * be given time in the withdrawal/reflection room
- * have parents/caregivers contacted
- * miss out on school events
- * not feel good about themselves
- * not perform as well as they could
